CALL TIMES RECITAL DAY-SATURDAY, JUNE 19

All dancers will enter at the backstage door and will be escorted to their dressing room. Parents will not be allowed in the backstage or dressing room area. Students not dancing in show 2, will be released at the backstage door after the show. All other dancers will be taken to change and then the eating area.

** Dancers should come in leotards and performance tights, hair and make-up done. Please use long-wearing lipstick in a berry color that will not come off. Bring your dance bag with all shoes*

Costumes provided by AABD will be at the theater.

K/1- Arrive at 1:00pm backstage door.

Grades 2/3 AND Leap N Learn – Arrive at 1:15pm backstage door.

Grades 4 and up- Arrive at 1:00pm backstage door.

Ballet Academy- Arrive at 12:45pm at the backstage door.

Rehearsal onstage- This is a closed rehearsal per theater rules.

***Parents will only be allowed to enter the theater when the house opens 20-30 minutes before the show. Families may not congregate in the Lobby at any time and must exit the building following the performance. Dancers finished after the first show may be picked up at stage door.**

- **No flash photography.**
- **Recital SHOWTIMES Saturday at 2:30 pm and 4:45pm. Families are assigned to a show and will receive 2 tickets per dancer. Theater capacity is at 20%. We only have enough seats between the 2 shows to cover all our AABD families. You may not change your show time.**
- **Attendance will be taken as dancers arrive, please be on time.**
- **Please provide healthy snacks and water for your dancer. Please WATER only.**
- **Keep rooms clean and tidy. Please leave rooms better than when you arrived.**
- **Younger dancers, please bring some quiet games to play with your friends.**
- **ALL DANCERS must label ALL their belongings, including leotards, tights, and shoes.**
- **No undergarments are to be worn under tights or costumes of any age level.**
- **NO parents in dressing rooms or backstage.**

COSTUME REQUIREMENTS

******Please make sure your name is written in ALL shoes and leotards!!!***

Leap N Learn- Sat- 9:30 Ballet- Hair in professional bun (see details in hair and make-up)

Ballet-AABD provided costume, Bloch T1921G footed pink tights (3T and under) or Body Wrappers Style C39 (Classic Pink) tights, pink leather ballet slippers. **Boys**: black tights, black ballet shoes or tap shoes, white class dance shirt.

Tap- AABD provided costume, pink ballet tights, black tap shoes.

Grades K/1- Hair in professional bun (see details in hair and make-up)

Ballet E Fasselt- AABD provided costume, Body Wrappers Style C39 (Classic Pink) tights, pink leather ballet slippers

Tap-E Fasselt -AABD provided costume, Body Wrappers Style C39 (Classic Pink) tights, black tap shoes

Musical Theater/Jazz-E Fasselt -AABD provided costume, Body Wrappers Style C39 (Classic Pink) tights, black jazz shoes

Grades 2/3- Hair in professional bun (see details in hair and make-up)

Ballet- E Fasselt- AABD provided costume, Body Wrappers Style C39 (Classic Pink) tights, Pink leather ballet slippers

Hip Hop/Acro- E Fasselt – AABD Purple uniform leotard, AABD provided leggings, hip hop sneakers

Musical Theater/Jazz-E Fasselt – AABD provided costume, pink ballet tights, black jazz shoes

Tap-E Fasselt- AABD provided costume, pink ballet tights, black tap shoes

Grades 4/5- Hair in professional bun (see details in hair and make-up)

Ballet-Walters- AABD provided costume, Grishko/American Movement 1012 (Classic Ballet Pink) tights, Pink leather ballet slippers

Musical Theater/Jazz- R Walters & H. Duncan– AABD provided costume, pink ballet slippers

Tap- R Walters & H. Duncan- AABD provided costume, black tap shoes

INTERMEDIATE/ADVANCED- Hair in professional bun (see details in hair and make-up)

ALL BALLE, POINTE - AABD provided costume, Nude leo if wanted (no plastic straps), Grishko/American Movement Style 1012 (Classic Ballet Pink) tights, pink leather ballet slippers and/or pointe shoes.

Contemporary Ballet-M. Evans - Black camisole leotard, black tights (not leggings), AABD provided skirt

Contemporary- H.Duncan- White camisole leotard, AABD provided skirt, bare legs, bare feet

Contemporary- M. Hoiriis-Black camisole leotard, black tights, bare feet

Modern/Contemporary-C Walters- AABD provided costume, bare legs, bare feet

Hip Hop- AABD provided costume, black leggings (not tights), hip hop sneakers

Lyrical- M.Evans -AABD provided costume, bare legs, bare feet

Musical T (adv and Academy) -White camisole leotard, AABD provided skirt, bare legs, tan character shoes.

Tap- K Brown- Black camisole Leotard, AABD provided skirt, black tights, black tap shoes

Jazz Funk- C. Broussard- Any color solid T-shirt, black leggings (not tights), sneakers

Academy Contemporary and Modern- Black camisole, black tights (not leggings), bare feet

DIRECTIONS TO THE THEATER

860 Rossbacher Way, Marietta, GA 30060

Coming from Kennesaw, I-75 South

The Marietta Theatre is in the Joe Mack Wilson Student Center

Take exit 263 (South Marietta Parkway-GA 120 Loop/KSU Marietta Campus)

Turn right onto South Marietta Parkway

Go approx. one mile and turn left onto Rossbacher Way, SE. Turn right onto Polytechnique Lane and you will be at the back of the theater and stage door on the left side. Please look for AABD Staff.

Hair and Make-up

HAIR

ALL DANCERS: Regular performance bun

Leads- Hair as discussed with Ms. Susan

****See YouTube video “How to Make a Correct Classical Hair Bun for Ballet” by Mr. Kobena. Most dancers use bun pins/hairpins instead of bobby pins. The video is long, but the girls learn to complete the buns very quickly with practice. Please do not use bun “makers”, a ballet bun should be as flat as possible and look like a cinnamon roll 😊**

Bring EXTRA hair (hairpins or bobby pins, hair nets, hairspray and gel) and make-up supplies!

BALLET PERFORMANCE BUN INSTRUCTIONS

Bun Materials:

- Hairspray or hair gel
- Hair pins (Thicker type with plastic tips work the best and are worth the money)
- Elastic band (Thin clear elastics allow for a flatter bun than regular ponytail holders)
- Comb & brush
- Hair net

Steps to Make the Perfect Ballet Bun:

1. To start, wet your hands and hair with water. This will give you better control. Gather the hair and pull it back. Apply hair gel if you need more control.
2. Use a hairbrush to smooth out rough or uneven areas. Form a ponytail by brushing the hair up from the jaw line to the top part of the back of the head. This will form a high bun. The placement of the ponytail determines the placement of the bun.
3. Use an elastic hair band to secure the ponytail. A tidy ponytail with hair drawn snugly back is the key to making a good ballet bun.
4. Apply more water or gel to keep the hair neat and twist the ponytail in a couple of sections.
5. Coil the ponytail into a tight **FLAT** circle.
6. Use hair pins all around the coil to secure it to the rest of the hair. Slide each pin through the outer part of the coil, then into the base of the bun.
7. Wrap a fine hair net around the bun. Keep twisting and wrapping so the hair net tightly secures the bun. Add a few more pins.
8. With long thick hair, you may end up with a bun that will protrude too much. A flatter bun is preferable. To flatten, remove all pins; the hair net will hold the bun. Then flatten the bun and re-pin all around the bun.
9. When the bun and hair are all secure, use hairspray.

MAKEUP

Leap N Learn, K/1, 2/3: Eyeshadow, blush, mascara, and long-wearing lipstick. Apply all make-up at home.

Grades 4/5: Heavy street makeup. Apply all make-up at home.

Grades 6 and up: Full stage makeup. Apply all make up at home.

**For full stage makeup only, see YouTube video “Royal Ballet Inspired Makeup Tutorial” by Lisa Eldridge. Do not use rhinestones as shown in the video. Make sure to contour under cheek bones, jawline and collarbones. Eyebrows need attention too, especially if you are very fair!

- Lipstick (all levels): burgundy/plum/berry color
- Eye Shadow (all levels): brown family
