act 1

A beggar woman arrives at the castle of a Prince. The woman asks for shelter and offers the Prince a rose. Repulsed, the Prince turns her away. The beggar warns him not to judge by appearances and then reveals herself as a beautiful enchantress. The Prince tries to apologize, but she has already seen his lack of kindness. She conjures a curse, transforming him into a beast. The curse can only be broken if he learns to love another and receives the other's love in return before the last petal of the rose falls; if not, he will remain a beast forever.

A peasant woman named Belle lives nearby with her father, Maurice. Belle, the object of unwanted attention from a local hunter, Gaston, perceives him as an egomaniac, lunkhead. Gaston arranges a wedding ceremony for himself and Belle and invites the entire town. Belle declines, which serves as a hard blow to Gaston's ego.

Meanwhile, Maurice rides off to a fair to sell his newest invention, but gets lost as night falls and seeks shelter from a storm. Cold and tired, he stumbles upon a castle with enchanted household items welcoming him; including, Lumière the Candelabra, Mrs. Potts the Teapot and her son Chip, Fluerette the Maid, and Cogsworth the Clock. The Beast, however, is enraged when he discovers Maurice and against Maurice's wishes locks him in the dungeon of the castle tower.

Belle, who worries when her father does not return, sets out to find him. Eventually, she winds up at the castle and finds Maurice in the tower dungeon. The Beast finds her and she offers herself in exchange for her father's life, giving her word to remain in the castle forever. The Beast agrees and releases Maurice who reluctantly leaves for home.

Belle meets the enchanted objects who welcome her with an elaborate dinner and a show. The household items are excited and optimistic that Belle may fall

in love with the Beast and cause them to become human again. The Beast and Belle begin to fall in love and enjoy time together.

The Beast notices that Belle seems melancholy. She tells him that she wishes to see Maurice again, if just for a moment. The Beast gives her the magic mirror, explaining that it will allow her to see anything she desires. The magic mirror reveals that Maurice is lost and sick in the forest. The Beast, having fallen in love with Belle, releases her so she might rescue her father.

Intermission

act 2

Back at the village, Belle assures everyone that the Beast is kind and gentle. Out of jealousy and anger, Gaston tells the mob that Belle is crazy. Gaston then convinces the villagers that the Beast is dangerous to the entire town and rallies them to storm the castle and kill the Beast.

The villagers arrive at the castle and Gaston finds the Beast alone and attacks him. The Beast does not defend himself because he has given up hope of being able to see Belle again. As soon as he sees Belle, he gains the will to fight Gaston. A battle ensues between the two, but the Beast cannot kill Gaston. He tells Gaston to leave and never come back. As the Beast turns away, Gaston stabs him in the back, and the Beast falls.

Belle tries to reassure the badly wounded Beast that everything will be fine, but he knows that his wound is fatal. The Beast tells her that he was happy to see her one last time, and dies succumbing to his injury. Belle, in tears, whispers that she loves him just before the last petal falls from the rose. The spell is broken. The Beast, brought back to life, is returned to his human form. The castle becomes beautiful again and Belle and Prince Adam live happily ever after.

It's hard to believe we are finishing our fourth year of opening AABD. What an amazing adventure it has been so far. We are so excited about the new opportunities coming our way!

To recap year four, we started with Moscow Ballet auditions for the visiting Moscow Ballet's Nutcracker performed in December. The Kakaty Family very graciously hosted Lana, our Moscow auditioner and we enjoyed her classes for the week. Then came rehearsals not only for The Nutcracker, but also for our AABD Annual Christmas show performed in November where we had over 90 AABD students participating. Not only can we rehearse one show at a time, we are a talented bunch that can rehearse several shows. Immediately following the Christmas show, we started rehearsal for Coppélia, so many of the dancers were rehearsing three shows at a time. Good practice for the professional world!

February and March brought two ballet Competitions in which AABD showed exemplary skills and integrity and were rewarded with summer intensive scholarships. Speaking of scholarships, AABD dancers will be traveling all over the country this summer dancing for up to 6 weeks. I am thrilled to say that over 50% of our dancers received scholarships totaling almost \$40,000. This shows the dedication and hard work of these very talented kids.

April will bring the annual Kennesaw State Dance Festival which will be a fun weekend of dancing and performing for our high school students. And lastly, Atlanta hosts a ballet competition in May, which will showcase 25 AABD dancers competing with over 50 entries. That's a lot of hard work and sweat!

August will bring the opening of our new studio with 13,000 square feet of dance space! Two floors, four studios to start, upstairs and downstairs lounge, custom floors and equipment with easy access in and out of the intersection with a traffic signal AND plenty of parking. We are all very excited!

I must mention a few people who help run the studio and I am not kidding when I say that. Lori Joiner, runs the entire office on her own. She answers all your emails, takes care of all the registrations, class changes and accounts, organizes the show volunteers and creates, updates and maintains our beautiful website! I cannot run this school without her, thank you Lori!!!

As always, Mr. Terry is there to do anything from fixing barres, walls, and even toilets. And he builds the most amazing props. Melody Ferguson paints those awesome props and makes Terry look even better!
